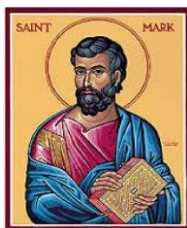

We are not allowed to sing songs for the time being. Offertory will be collected at the entrance of the church in a box (no passing of basket). Other directions will be given at the introduction of each mass.

Few Things to keep in mind

- Please Keep social distance at all time at least 1 metre.
- Family can sit together
- Stewards will guide you to the seats
- Entry and exit through different doors
- Use hand sanitizer at entrance and exit
- No any gathering other than mass participation
- Use of toilet only for emergency.
- Sit only in the marked area given
- No singing is allowed for the time being
- Prayers in low voice only
- Communion is only in one kind and received silently (no Amen).
- Please provide your contact details to the steward for any emergency need in future
