Prayer of the Faithful

30th Sunday – Ordinary Time.



Celebrant: ... *Trusting in God's love for us, we bring him our needs and the needs of our human family.*

Reader: ... *We pray for the Church that she will never lose sight of her mission to put flesh on God's love for his creation. . . Lord, in your mercy*

Rd. ... *We pray for the world, that war will yield to peace, that bitterness will turn to compassion, and that hatred will give way before the love God offers to all . . . Lord in your mercy*

Rd. ... *We pray for migrants and refugees to our country: may they be welcomed with justice and care. Lord in your mercy*

Rd. ... *We pray for ourselves: may we have the grace to love tenderly, to act justly and to walk humbly with God. . . Lord, in your mercy*

Rd. ... *We pray for those who are suffering from self-isolation. In their loneliness help us to prove that we are good neighbours to them. . . . Lord, in your mercy*

Rd. ... *We pray for those in our world who suffer because of who they are or what they believe: may all people be granted the freedom to worship God. . . Lord, in your mercy.*

Rd. ... *We pray for all our deceased relatives and friends, may they receive their heavenly reward. . . Lord, in your mercy*

Celebrant: ... *Father, you loved the world so much that you sent your only Son to redeem us. In your great love hear these prayers, which we make in his name, who is Lord forever and ever.*
