Rd. ... *We pray for those who have grown lukewarm in their faith: may the Holy Spirit drive out their apathy and coldness and rekindle the desire for heaven. . . Lord, hear us.*

Rd. . . *We pray for the church especially for the diocese of East Anglia that the new bishop to be elected will guide us in the way God inspires through the work of the Holy Spirit. .. Lord Hear us.*

Rd. ... *We pray for all who are sick, remembering those who have asked for our prayers: may the Holy Spirit comfort them in their illness and restore them to health. . . Lord, hear us.*

Rd. ... *May the Holy Spirit bring all who have died, especially for John Gerald and Fr Pius Vallooran may they find eternal rest in the vision and company of God. . . . Lord, hear us.*

Celebrant: ... *Loving God, giver of all that is good, fill our mouths with your praise, our hearts with your love and our lives with your service. Grant this through Christ our Lord.*
