

## OFFERTORY GIVING

*You may have seen that we now have electronic donation plates at both St. Mark's and Holy Family, which are placed at the back of the church. As fewer and fewer people are using cash, and more and more transactions are carried out using cards, the Diocese have investigated suppliers of suitable systems, and recommended the Dona system, which we are now using. You can give any amount by using your card in the usual way, with contactless payments possible up to £45, and a PIN required for larger amounts. There are suggested amounts on the first screen, but you can give any amount you wish. When you first give using this method, you will be asked if you wish to gift-aid the payment, and if so, you will be asked to provide your name and address details. Then, on every subsequent occasion when you use the system with that same card, your details will be recognised, and the payment will be automatically recorded for our gift aid claim. If you use a different card, then you will be asked to provide your details again. You do not have to gift aid payments if you do not wish to do so, or if you are not a taxpayer. At present, all giving using the system will go towards our general offertory for the general purposes of the Parish, but in due course, once we are all more confident using the system, we hope to add other causes, such as our buildings maintenance fund, and other collections. Just to summarise, the ways in which you can give towards the general offertory are:*

- *By a regular standing order – please see the website for details and a form (these payments can be gift aided);*
- *By parish envelope (cash or cheque) to be left in the weekly physical collection (these payments can be gift aided);*
- *By card payment using the new electronic collection plate (these payments can be gift aided).*
- *By internet banking payment to the Parish account using the details on the website – if you do this, it is important for gift aid that you state in the reference your name and initial, and, for our accounting, if it is not for general offertory, for example a Mass stipend, then that must be made clear in the reference also. Please email the Parish with details if you cannot provide sufficient information in the reference (again, these payments can be gift aided).*
- *By cash or cheque in the weekly collection (no gift aid will apply, except that we can claim a small general annual amount of gift aid on cash collections).*
