Sinod 2021-2023

The most requested item arising from the synodal process in our Diocese of East Anglia was a request for more adult catechesis. At the meeting of the College of Deacons in May, Bishop Alan asked the deacons to initiate the process. Following a meeting with Fr. Bineesh, we have decided to run a 'Journey of Faith' course for our parish. This will consist of a monthly talk covering two topics and with a social element, at St. Mark's Church, given by Deacon Clive, with a hand-out sheet which will also be attached to that week's newsletter. If there is sufficient interest the talk can be repeated at Holy Family Church, Brantham. The talks will cover the Catholic Faith, Liturgy, Prayer, Sacraments, Ethics and Social Justice; twenty-four subjects in all.
